# NEW MEXICO ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION

The NMAA, a member-led organization, provides leadership in interscholastic athletics & activities, promoting equitable participation and character development.

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# Scholastic Eligibility



- 2.0 GPA w/ no more than one F.
- Student must be enrolled in a minimum of 51% of a full time schedule.
- Students enrolled in partial schedule must be passing a minimum of 51% of a full time schedule to be eligible to participate.
- Summer School – one exact course can be replaced.
- Academically ineligible student may practice.



# Residential Requirements



- Open Enrollment Choice
  - Incoming freshman
  - 8<sup>th</sup> grade students participating at the high school level
  - 8<sup>th</sup> grade form
- Bona Fide Residence
- Transfer Student (180 School Day Sit)
- Guardianship
  - Legal Guardianship must be Authorized by Judicial Authority and must have been in place a minimum of one year prior to eligibility being granted.



# Residential Requirements



- Charter School
  - Public school within their home attendance area.
- Home School-
  - Public school within their home attendance area
  - 3 activities/athletics
- Alternative School
  - Public School within home attendance area



# Foreign Students



- Foreign Students in US without Parents or Legal Guardians.
  - ineligible for 180 school days sit.
- Foreign Exchange Students-
  - eligible for one year.
