# SENIOR TOURNAMENT

**2 Feb 2019**

1.) Qualifications:

- A senior during the current NMHSBA school year of this event that has not previously participated in a NMHSBA Senior Tournament event.
- In good standing with NMHSBA (Financially and Eligibility)
  - Payment for school tournament events prior to senior event is up-to-date IAW NMHSBA records.
  - Met NMAA and school eligibility during current grading period that event is held.
    - IAW NMAA rules, a student must be taking 51% and in good standing with school.
- Bowled at least 5 games in current NMHSBA season tournament schedule.
- Filled out and turned in entry form, transcripts, & fees by cutoff date on entry form. Late entries may not be accepted.

2.) Start and Check-in: (anticipated - 9 am). Check-in no later than 30 minutes prior to squad time.

3.) Fees/Transcripts:

- \$15 per bowler paid by cutoff date on entry form. May be Refundable, if NMHSBA notified 1 week prior event.
- Student provides **unofficial** transcript to individual identified on entry form.

4.) Format:

- Number of Divisions (two or three) determined based on senior entries received.**
- Qualifying (~9 am-12:00): Four (4) games bowled by all seniors.
- Double-elimination brackets (~1 pm-4:30). Largest of top 12 or 25% in each division.

5.) Point/Pin Credits:

- GPA. In qualifying only, not in brackets.
  - o >4.0 -> 100 points/pins
  - o 4.0 -> 80 points/pins
  - o 3.5-3.999 -> 60 points/pins
  - o 3.0-3.499 -> 40 points/pins
  - o 2.5-2.999 -> 20 points/pins
- Games bowled. In qualifying only, not in brackets. (1 point/pin per game bowled in NMHSBA tournaments.)
- Years Participated. In qualifying only, not in brackets.
  - o 5 points/pins for each year participating in at least 5 games in NMHSBA tournaments. Points start accumulating with a student's 9th grade season and will not exceed 20 points.
- Average Points. NMHSBA Average table to points/pins will be used based on highest senior average.
- Scores bowled in Senior Tournament.

6.) Awards/Recognition:

- Plan to provide all participants a bowling pin to get signatures on.
- All bowlers that qualify for double-elimination brackets will receive a certificate and scholarship funds.

7.) Other:

- A coach or sponsor must be present with the senior(s). Must be on list provided by head coach.
- All appropriate NMHSBA guidelines (dress code, behavior, etc) apply. Violation is cause for not bowling.**
- Admission for spectators will be \$5.
